Listening to God—Week 10

Excerpts from Chapter 4C of 'The Prophetic Voice of God' by Lana Vanser

The Lord may share secrets with you concerning someone else, someone you know. That doesn't necessarily mean that you are to share it with that person. The Lord will often reveal secrets of His heart so we can pray and align with what He wants to do and shift things through our prayers.

Sometimes secrets that He releases are for you to see, not to sound aloud.

He sometimes shares insights that uncover the plans of the enemy. His heart is for us to live in the victory that is already ours.

There is a place of divine insight that we can live in as believers, where He allows us to see the plans of the enemy so we can be one step ahead.

Ever had the strongest 'gut feeling' to not go somewhere, or a dream showing what would happen if you went down a certain pathway?

God wants us living so close to His heart that we are living in a place of discernment and hearing His heart. When He reveals a strategy of the enemy, we turn it on its head before it can have a chance to take root.

He will speak to you about the glorious things to come and the plans that He has for you.

What if I don't understand the warning I've received or know what to do with it? Don't try and work it out logically.

Run back to the One who gave the revelation and ask...

- Lord, what do you want me to do with what You showed me?
- What do I pray?
- What is Your strategy?

Often when the Lord reveals things, we may not get the understanding straight away; we get it later.

What are You dreaming about today, Jesus?

What do You want to say to me today?

Listening Time

These 30 minutes are 'You and Him' time with Jesus.

If you are good at being still and listening, do that.

Otherwise read through some of these scripture quotations from Chapter 4, and if something tugs at your heart, spend time pondering that scripture.

Or do a bit of both, and repeat as often as needed. It might take many times to learn to slow down and be attentive to Jesus, so be expectant and patient.

So let us thank God for giving us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Cor 15:57
