## Listening to God—Week 5

Excerpts from Chapter 3A of 'The Prophetic Voice of God' by Lana Vawser

I remember in this vision experiencing a level of joy and peace that I had never known on earth. Jesus began to speak to the very core of me about who I was. It wasn't "This is what I want you to do' or "This is who I want you to become". It was all about, "This is who you are".

When He speaks, He reveals more of who He is!

When He speaks, He reveals more of His glorious nature. When He speaks, He reveals more of His glorious goodness. When He speaks, He reveals another facet of who He is.

As God's people we need to live in a place where we are feasting upon every word that flows from His mouth every day.

Whatever 'form' He chooses to communicate to His people, all of it is simply another expression of His Heart and desire for relationship.

Even when the Lord speaks to convict and correct, He does it out of His pure heart of love that says, 'I love you too much to leave you where you are. You are so much better than this. This isn't who you are; come up higher.'

## Listening Time
