## Listening to God—Week 6

*Excerpts from Chapter 3B of 'The Prophetic Voice of God' by Lana Vamser*

I began to live my life with greater intentionality, looking for Him,  
and I started to notice a certain symbol appearing everywhere almost daily.  
It was the Eiffel Tower.

He wants to speak to us more than we desire to hear, and we must have  
confidence that when He speaks He confirms His word.

The weeks went on, the Eiffel Tower continued to appear everywhere, and  
the question arose: 'What are You saying, Lord?' One day, a sense filled me  
so intensely to research the history of the Eiffel Tower and what it  
represents. As I began to read these facts, the Lord started to speak to me,  
using the Eiffel Tower as an image of what He called me to be.

The Lord taught me 3 very important lessons through that experience:

- Pay attention to repetition.
- Ask the Lord for the Spirit of revelation and wisdom.
- Research.

For weeks and weeks and weeks I saw 11:11. I had no idea what was going  
on, except that I knew in this repetition God was speaking to me again in a  
creative way.

I longed to know what it meant, and the waiting began to frustrate me. He  
taught me that every time I saw 11:11, that was a moment when He was  
invading my world. He was whispering to me, 'I'm here'. Now every time I  
saw it, it made my heart sing, 'Oh, hi Lord!'. But I kept asking what it meant.

Then I heard a friend preach about seeing 11:11 everywhere, and how He  
had led her to John 11:11 about Jesus saying it was time to go and awaken  
Lazarus. It was a season of awakening not only for me, but it was also a  
word for the body of Christ.

What are You dreaming about today, Jesus?

What do You want to say to me today?'

## Listening Time

These 30 minutes are 'You and Him' time with Jesus.

If you are good at being still and listening, do that.

Otherwise read through some of these scripture quotations from Chapter 3, and if something tugs at your heart, spend time pondering that scripture.

Or do a bit of both, and repeat as often as needed. It might take many times to learn to slow down and be attentive to Jesus, so be expectant and patient.

The evidence of three, or at least two, witnesses is necessary  
to sustain the charge. 2 Cor 13:1b

A single witness cannot suffice to convict a man of a crime or offence  
of any kind; whatever the misdemeanour,  
the evidence of two witnesses or three  
is required to sustain the charge. Deut 19:15

I have never failed to remember you in my prayers and to thank God  
for you. May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory,  
give you a spirit of wisdom and perception of what is revealed,  
to bring you to full knowledge of Him. Eph 1:16-17

Then Jesus added, 'Our friend Lazarus is resting,  
I am going to wake him.' John 11:11

Do not let a Word of His fall to the ground.

Record it, ponder it, ask Him to reveal more about it. Act on it.
