## Listening to God—Week 9

*Excerpts from Chapter 4B of 'The Prophetic Voice of God' by Lana Vamser*

In your journey with the Lord and hearing His voice, if you still have those times of fear and anxiety I want to encourage you—give yourself grace. Enjoy your private place with the Lord.

Invite the Holy Spirit to show you more and more the way that you hear from Him, and talk to others about the ways that you experience God and His heart. But whatever way you hear from God, don't shut it down because you don't understand it or it doesn't look like someone else's relationship with the Lord.

One day something shifted in my heart. My love for Jesus and the joy I found in my relationship with Him began to outweigh the feeling of comparison or the pressure to 'fit in'.

You will be surprised how many times the Lord will speak to you as you just position yourself to enjoy Him and be with Him.

He will not turn a deaf ear to a heart cry that is asking for greater sensitivity to His presence.

Not everything the Lord shares with you is to be shared with others. There is a very important place we must cultivate in our relationship with the Lord where He knows that He can trust us with what He is sharing.

Ask for discernment with what you feel the Lord is speaking and revealing to you. We must be asking the Holy Spirit to lead us to those whom you can share with.

We must treat His heart with sensitivity regarding what we share and don't share.

What are You dreaming about today, Jesus?

What do You want to say to me today?'

## Listening Time

These 30 minutes are 'You and Him' time with Jesus.

If you are good at being still and listening, do that.

Otherwise read through some of these scripture quotations from Chapter 4, and if something tugs at your heart, spend time pondering that scripture.

Or do a bit of both, and repeat as often as needed. It might take many times to learn to slow down and be attentive to Jesus, so be expectant and patient.

The Lord's friendship is for those who revere Him;  
to them He reveals His covenant. Psalm 24(25):14

Peter, James, John and Andrew questioned Him privately,  
'Tell us, when is this going to happen,  
and what sign will there be that all this is about to be fulfilled?'  
Mark 13:3-4\*
